

May 1901

I went to Flavin's A.M. & gave him the money to pay the Mason Ellis for building the wall he finished on Wednesday then I went to Cedar Grove W. fine rain last night cloudy while there. Clear & warm distant thunder P.M. Cooler this evening Sunday 12 I & Mary went to J.D.'s to dinner W. Cool & Clear A.M. dark & heavy squalls came up P.M. a little distant thunder pretty strong wind pretty heavy showering 13 J.W. Henry Chord & pulled off some Caterpillars A.M. Henry sowed feed corn in west part of field behind Cedar house & south of bush P.M. I went to Cedar Grove for seed corn A.M. Aceline Mary went to Muckheim P.M. W. Cool N. wind Clear. I brought 70 Hemlock from Ratcliffes @ \$10.00 per M 14 Boy pulled down old fence along north end of calf pasture & dressed a lot of round rails to make a straight fence along there I & Mary went to M.C.'s to dinner W. Clear but Cool very fine P.M. Hemanis were here to dinner today 15 Boy put in the posts & finished the fence I brought home Chop the plow & set the back garden P.M.

May 1901

I took Susanna to J.D.'s & went to Cedar Grove A.M. & brought home \$6.00 worth of sugar granulated @ 21¢ for 23¢ Cooking 23¢ I & Anne started after 2 P.M. & went to Pease's place & got a fine mess of D. Musk rooms & called at J.D.'s & brought Susanna home W. very fine day a white frost last night I don't think there was any damage done Thomas called this morning & took Mary with him she came home after dinner she says they have a young son Occasion day 16 all went to Meeting at Heman except I he took Butter & Eggs to Susanna (Susanna went too) remarks & sermon on Acts part of 1st C. by Rev. C. John Rayner & Daniel Ramer & his son Martin were here to dinner Daniels were here to D.P.M. & very fine 17 Henry went to Heman to fill along A.M. went to Boy's to help to plow & scrape the big ditch from Boyds line south he helped while there rain stopped there A.C. cut seed Potatoes P.M. J. & Boy's took off some more grading on Pickering townline P.M. I & Mary called at Thomas's P.M. the little boy he is doing well we also called at Flavin's little Eva is not well W. a few fine showers though to the day a sharp rain chop of thunder at bed time no rain before or after it is more thunder
