	17	Wednesday Fine in A.M. clouded over rained some in evening also at noon. I plowed in No 4 S.W. and harrowed it. Drove around by fence at night to weave some found one wire broken went home for papers etc.		
	18	Thursday Raining most A.M. cloudy all day color at night. We put up chop then I stretched loose wire on fence and wove some more. Mother up in A.M. Father and Willie came back from St Joe Island today. In P.M. Willie harrowed green crop land and I wove some more fence. St Joe Expenses Fare \$18.75 cap 50 bush 25 soap 10 meals 50 present 100		1875 235
	19	Friday Fine sunny day. Willie took chop to Wilcox brought load manure from Steals to S.L. We both plowed mangol land in P.M. We wove some of fence in A.M. Sold to Jackson cream 7 qts \$1.20 Willie and May drove down in evening. We heard that Uncle Tom St Joe died yesterday. Chop 40	120	40
