30 Fine bright day, but cold wind Charlotte Dougald called in afternoon, so did Lygie  
 Mrs John McArthur of Lancaster, died in St Lukes Hospital Ottawa on Saturday  
 Mrs H. Pigeon paid 3<sup>00</sup> rent
