

- 17. Just returned from prayer meeting, where one of the Miss Summers of Albiquick delighted the people with two solos. Mrs Summers and two daughters are visiting her friends
- 18. Fine day. Mary came to ask our folk to a little pic nic tomorrow. for Jim Coattanach & wife
- 19. Another fine day. Birdie went with John to the Front. Jimmie went after dinner Mrs Summers and her two daughters and Mrs Brown (sister of Mrs Summers), called in afternoon. I went to vestry to pack the bale for N. W. There was no one there but myself. after an hour Mrs John Dingwall came, we done nothing, all the stuff was not there
- 20. Put out strawberry plants among the carrots at 10 A.M. took a notion to go to the N. Branch on the Kings road about Mc Gillivray's place I was upset off the road by Wilson's team which got away from him. I got Myrdor's buggy wrecked some. And a good shaking to myself. I kept on to Aunt Floris
- 21. Rain all day. Birdie baked in oven I am so stiff and sore I did not get up until 10.30 A.M. To sugar 25 on 20<sup>th</sup>, Got at factory 4 lb butter 4 1/4 cheese
- 22. Fine though dull until evening then rain. Birdie made the washing. Maggy, Penning & two Miss Finleys from Mills Corners, near Ottawa, called about 4.40 P.M. it began to rain, we prevailed on them to remain to tea. they did.
- 23. Dull with showers all day. Pa got 4 1/2 lbs steak 70, lb tea at J. G's 30 cts
- 24. Rained in the night. Now 9.30 A.M. Fine. I am up every day, but do very little

- 25. Muddy went to work today, I know not where Pa and Jimmie are cutting stones. The bale for N. W. packed today in vestry
- 26. Fine day. Our young folk are going to J. G's to tea. 2 1/2 lb butter factory
- 27. Fine day, rain last night. Birdie sent the eggs to the store 4 doz. due bill 60<sup>cts</sup>
- 28. The boys were at a party at E. Dingwall's last night. Jimmie drew a load of gravel. Had Maussa all day, putting cement on stable floor Birdie was colouring carpet rags. Got at Willis for the eggs. 3 packets D. Dyes 30. Just 5 one packet D. D at J. G's 10<sup>cts</sup>. I am not getting butter very fast. not able to do much
- 29. Jimmie was spending the <sup>last</sup> evening at J. G's Very fine day. Jimmie drew 2 gravel Cornie began to load the run. Maussa yrd day Got the invoice for cement & felt \$16.15. Freight
- 30. Pa went to Cornwall today took cars at Summers Got \$100 from D. P. Got at Phillips 2 cts wool under wear 4. 2 white shirts \$2. 1 necktie 25 6 25  
1 woollen night cap 25- 96  
Killed an old hen. 70 sugar 25 butter 60  
1 pan bread 20 Our young folk were at a party at J. H. Mc Gillivray's last night. report a good time
- 31. Fine day. Miss Ella Walker sang a solo in our church
