Cold frosty N.W. wind all day. very stormy occasional sunshine very frosty last night and tonight. We spread hard manure from pig pen on No 7 also the 7 rank load that was on the wagon. In P M Wm & Joe Frank got load hay and are put a load on for dinner. We are feeding 3 little pigs by hand Willie down town at night got at Russells collar 12 Phillips caught on the 25 of Jackson's peppercorns 10

Fine day cold air sunny. Our ~~Sabbath~~ Sunday. Mr Cran preached A M from Luke 23: 39-43. We used individual cups first time to-day. Neither Bellaver Mary out at church to-day. Mr Brown preached at night to united congregation from Acts 6: 15. church coll 30

Willie took 2060 lbs hay to dinner got 9 25 hay 20 got at Widd's only one 25 charcoal 15 bread mixer 275; 125 each put on hand got at Widdings on 1/2 blocks for what 8 pounds out 285 150 Willie got 2 loads manure from Frank in P M 6 pile. Set from Wm Frank for hay payable in manure \$10.00 paid him 15 for manure Mr Ritchie up for dinner. I cleaned seed out etc.
