Cloudy, wet, snowing and blowing in PM very
stormy and cold by night winter weather.
Willie went up to Arthur to-day got ton loan
\$20.00 shorts 420 got dinner at Uncle Mills.
I skinned sheep that was found dead took
down porch etc in AM. In PM I went to
Lena Mills funeral. We sent \$2.00 to
charity fair fund 5 cts postage. Jim Able
came in PM for 7 loaves + 8 pigs got \$38.00 for them
butter money 97 Schain 40 gone to Mother 500.00 loan

Ground white with snow and frozen hard
very cold AM and very windy sunny
got more moderate by night. very little
growth no blossoms out or nearly out in trees
Wm Byers over in morning with horse Willie
which he traded with us for Jack also gave me 13 yds old
We went for load hay from other barn and weighed
200 lbs of it in bundles which Willie took to Mrs
Quarrie in PM got \$1.00 for it then he brought load
manure from Brokens we spread it on No 1 also
to more loads with spreader 4 horses and also
plowed a little. We left young cattle out to-night
for first time fed some hay out side to them.
