 14 Rain again. To 2 lbs sulphur to fumigate
 the hen house which is infested by lice

 24 To 1/2 lb sausages 35 cts 6 lbs round poor
 Monday 40 cts. About 4. P. M. Sandy
 put in an appearance. drove from
 Green Valley. Mercury to 86 48
 25 Bridie got home this morning. Mercury 87
 26 Very hot 88. Some say Saturday was
 hotter than today 1 gall oil oil gall 3 - 30
 27 Pa left this morning for Caledon
 with Duncan Christie, Uncle S.
 and I went to call at the Mann
 in forenoon. he left this evening.
 Murdy drove him to Green Valley
 Hot today. It was after 12 last night
 when Murdy got home. He has a man
 cutting the oats with a binder
