Adam Armstrong in at noon to see about our application for prize competition Mrs Mackie over AM with some Rhubarb. Harry Armstrong in P.M. for corn sheller. Mary and I drove up in evening in rain to Greigsons. There was held there a funeral service for Dave Greigson killed in action in France a while ago. Mr Brown spoke from the text saith his life shall lose it and he that loseth his life for my sake the same shall save it. We gave Wm Rutherford ride down.

26 Wednesday

195 Cold, windy. Sunny and cloudy. Willie took cream down got at 7 & 8. W.C.G.D. corn 70ds tomatoes 15 oatmeal 25 meat at Bengers 85ds got tooth attended to. C. Asken came up got load hay. I hauled rails from No 5 up to No 6 to make fence across from back to S.S. and I built some of it P.M. We sowed 8 more rows W No 7 corn P.M. making 80 rows Willie plowed more land.

27 Thursday

Hard frost last night ice on water. Fine sunny cool. a little windy. Willie took 12 day eggs to 70 & \$2.16 got yeast cake 5ds balance 211 on after he brought up 70 & 5 We gave dinner to an Englishman looking for work also gave him a pair pants he helped us with pigs.
