Willie chopped horse piled tiles on boards etc. A noon D. Allan came in told us he had car of 35 cattle at station and only wanted 25 and asked if we wanted any Willie drove up to station with him, I drove Bella down after then went up to railway tracks en route to station met D Allan gave him ride up O S R & along Gessis side road and met Willie and two boys bringing the cattle. We didnt take any I plowed some after. Willie went down town at night got at Simpsons bread 12 ds at Russells rubbers 75 ds. Belle stayed down
