Mon Apr 29th clear and hot 84 deg in the shade. I finished taking potatoes out of pits widow Braggs boys were helping. after digging in the garden

Tue Apr 30th cloudy and hot. was digging in the garden and setting fruit trees I had ordered

Wed May 1st clear most of the day and cool. I planted a few early potatoes

Thu May 2nd cloudy and thunder showers not doing much to day

Fri May 3rd clear and cool. sawd some wood

Sat May 4th clear and warm. a frost last night I cleared out the cow stable cut wood and trimmed apple trees. the plumb trees beginning to come in blow

Sun May 5th clear and pleasant. I went with David Will to Quarterley meeting at Florence

Mon May 6th clear and warm. not doing much

Tue May 7th cloudy most of the day & warm Walter plowed my bit of a garden

Wed May 8th clear part of the day and hot. in the fore I went down and castrated Dick's lambs. ~~after~~ after noon planted a few potatoes

Thu May 9th cloudy fore noon Showery a fine rain I was makein a chicken coop in the fore noon. not doing much the rest of the day

Fri May 10th clear and warm. not doing much to day working a little in the garden

Sun May 11th cloudy high Wind from the west and quite cold.

Mon May 13th cloudy and cool. I cut wood and wrote a couple of letters to the girls Mrs Boyington was helping Flora Snary

Tue May 14th cloudy part of the day and cool. I split wood part of the day. Mrs Boyington away

Wed May 15th cloudy part of the day a sharp frost last night. I was makeing a marker for markeing corn ground

Thu May 16th clear and hot in the middle of the day a frost last night. I planted my little patch with corn this fore noon. after wend with Bilton and got a setting of Dorking eggs
