Unfortunate Day Mild Kind of Fine Fernandez went across to A. Frasers Stanley and Leander drawing firewood a Fox passed over to the Back Bay got a Rat snowed some to Day Drew 3 loads of Firewood Wrote a Letter for the Star put a Dollar in it my Date is the 26 of Feb Leander to The store Bought of Mr Flaggerty 1 Box of Soda Biscuit 25 Soda 10 Fernandez came from Frasers 17th Shrove Sunday Unfortunate Day Quadragesima Randolph and Donald Spink here to Michel and 1 of Lewis Boys here had Horse and Cart Wanted Wheat for their Mare as she got in the ice gave them Wheat Leander to church to night Forces running about lots of them nice and Moderate Weather now got a Rat

18th Halloweens Birth Day / 1855 Fine Fernandez to Frasers to Work at Stones as they are Drawing to the Lancaster Wharf Wrote a Letter to Day to send to Dan cutting Logs 6 all Basswood Drew a Load of Firewood Indians Drawing from Christees Island to Day Set out Poison Below the Island South Side Shrove Monday Writing part of John Cameron's career since he left the Scottish Shore its on a Paper with BOL on the Inside 19th Shrove Tuesday George came to Thrash got 2 Foxes this Morning seen lots of Foxes running to Day began to Thrash the Rod Broke and had to go to the Blacksmiths with it snowed some Sent my 2 Letters to the Office for the Weekly Star with a Dollar in it the other to Dan with Register and Postage Money 9 cents Bought Sugar Left the Rod till Morning to get Fixed Skinned the 2 Foxes and 2 Muskrats

20th Ash Wednesday Randolph came with the Rod 25 cents paid made some legs for the Mill This is one of my best Days I eat no meat to Day Thrashed about 18 Bushels to Day 21st a Fortunate Day Randolph Brought Medicine Letter from City Virtually Association Sarnia about 22 Bushels of Wheat Thrashed killed 1/4 Rats

James Cameron Island 22nd of February 1901

Washingtons Birth Day Fine this Morning Thrashing till near 12 o'clock the Mill got rong George went Home Eddy Kershaw here Thrashed about 43 of oats Randolph went gave him a letter to put in the P.O to go tomorrow 2 cents postage City Virtually Association Sarnia A Man walked up the ice from the way of Lancaster passed on the south side of this Island in the afternoon Indians Drawing wood from Christees Island 23rd Unfortunate Day Fine cool sunshiny Leander and Stanley went to Lancaster to get part of the Thrashing mill Fixed at the Foundry can't do it to Day Ed Kershaw here to fix a handle in his axe Fernandez came from Frasers 24th St Mathias Day Lent Begins Quadragesima Sunday Leander to night ^{to church} got the Mail seen an Owl 25th Fine Fernandez to Frasers Boys some Logs from the Bush A Fortunate Day a change in the Moon Showed through the night 26th Fine Showed some Went to Lancaster Stanley and Leander for the Thrashing Machine see if was fixed A Fortunate Day Bought Cod Haddock got Soap Cold to night 27th Ember Day Fine Day cool Sunshine But cold Windy Frosty to night 28th Last Day of the Month Fine cool and Frosty Randolph here a Team came up the ice from the way of Lancaster passed up on the south side Boys sawing stove-wood its Lewis Boys that came up the ice they had ash for Baskets Windy to night 1st of MARCH St. David's Day The Festival of the Welsh Taffy's Day The Leek came in Fine sun Bright and clear some Windy kind of like a Lamb not much like a lion or adder-head

An Unfortunate Day Ember Day cleaning some wheat Thrawing some Windy Leander cropt with the Team Turned kind of cloudy or smoky near 5 o'clock commenced to snow or sleet Received a Letter from Sarnia Windy to night a Party at Summerstown tonight 2nd An Unfortunate Day Snowing Boys went to Mill about 20 Bushels turned very fine Froze hard to night Ember Day Fernandez Done at Frasers came home Sold his 2 Foxes 3 Dollars Leander
