- Thurs Apr 1. East wind a light shower. I went to service.
- Fri Apr 2. Good Friday showery in the morning, then a heavy thunder storm about three. Aunt Mattie at Mother's and Annie came here for tea. too cold for cleaning.
- Sat Apr 3. Fine but a terrific wind all dried up. Mrs Davidson and I at the Royal. "Too many husbands."
- Sun Apr 4. Fine but very cold east wind. Aunt Nellie and I at Lighted Church. Easter Sunday. Elizabeth and Annie called. Furnace It snowed and blowing very rough. I went to Church
