July 4 Ordered seeds today they are scarce and very high in price. also ordered 4 barrels of Lime Sulphur and 200 lbs Arsenate of Lead

July 5th. Forgot to mention that the bear saw his shadow on July 2nd means six weeks more winter they say. and it feels like it today. from 25 to 30 below zero this morning.

July 10th. very mild with rain this is only the third day that the thermometer has reached the 32 mark since Nov 16th

July 13 weather has been mild the last couple of days.

July 14 Heavy rain with thunder and Lightning.

July 15 very cold again.

July 19 heavy rain with thunder again. every thing flooded.

July 20 decidedly cold again saw across an old account of goods sold to Wm Carrol of Hamilton in years 1802 & 1803. prices very low - Apples 35[¢] and 40[¢] a bushel. Apples 10[¢] a bushel. Turnips 20[¢] a bushel. Butter from 13[¢] to 17[¢] lb - Eggs 12[¢] a doz.

July 21 Every thing getting scarce and high in price. ordered 500 bags of wheat today. costing 9^½ & 10[¢] up there.
