We started to clean up in barn took canvases off binder etc when Mr Laidlaw from O.A.C. came instead of Mr Spring to survey Maywoods ditch etc with view of suggesting his part in deepening it. Willie drove him to station after dinner paid I Mike for working at manger \$1.50. We plowed in No 5 P.M. 4 horses Willie chopped.

Went last night in on water fine sunny day Jim Graham and Merville Hill up all day picking potatoes we finished them to-day also carrots and cabbage. We also plowed some in No 5 also raked wads off potatoes and banded them to hollow at Linda's fence Willie down town at night got basket grapes summer 25ct paid boys \$1.00 Belle home AM drew money out of bank to send to Ames for bonds (govt) ^{workman} \$100.00 R B ~~100~~ borrowed \$150.00 cheque 25 ~~gone \$100 to add in fact~~ on I B \$23.38 totaling \$873.38 costing 1.17 to send to Toronto \$872.21 which with the \$100.00 given before 367 will 972.21 discount of \$27.79 on 1000.
