Diagnostic Aphorisms in Gynecology.—No. 1.

Speaking generally, during the child-bearing period, a tumor with missed monthly periods is pregnancy; a tumor with unaltered menstruation is non-uterine; a tumor with increased menstruation is a fibroid. When a woman has a large tumor, if she is very thin it is probably ovarian; if she is very fat it is probably uterine fibroid. We may vary this observation by saying that cystic tumors are associated with wasting, and solid tumors, except malignant ones, with adiposity.—Giles.
