Drawing Wood Broke the Whistle in not sure
 But I heard A C Cameron's Wife Departed to Bay
 Tomorrow Windy Time cool a few Grams snow
 12th Cutting and Drawing Firewood. Put in 2 Cocks of hay
 Windy 13th Cut Down the cherry tree at the lower
 Point cutting Brush kind of fine to day Tommorrow
 the Apple tree at the lower Point cut and
 this evening and cold raining and cold to night took
 up the line Randolph and I Peeling some apples
 14th Raining some snow east and changed to wet
 crossed to Hamilton got a Pease from John
 brought over a Pease box Got a Bag of yarn
 to finish the other Got a Bag of Apples Went
 to the store Bought 2lb Sea
 longer batches Heard K Jack's wife
 was Poorly Mrs Summers Poorly Got
 from A D Baker 33 3/4 lbs of Flour
 Flour in Summertown 25 or 25 a 1000 They took up
 their Potatoes at Hamilton that they had on the
 halves 3 Boats of hunters up to day from sore blowing
 hard to night Froze pretty hard to night 15th Cold
 blowing hard 16th Drawing Wood high Wind shot a
 Duck cutting stove Wood 17th crossed to Hamilton
 to help with the Potatoes Tom Hannon for Apples
 spreading Manure churning fixing the Bees
 for the Potatoes pretty cold to day Batch Hamilton
 at the Potatoes some cold in the fore Part
 of the day St Lukes Day 19th James Grant
 at Bees, at the Potatoes a fine day Spartan
 went down 20th One at Hamilton
 Mr Filton and Miles were fishing finished
 the Potatoes at Hamilton to day see Glen
 21st Came home from Hamilton Raining
 took a Basket of Apples and 2 Ten Kettle
 Potatoes Ducks Plenty Mr Filton passed up

Sunday a Fortunate Day Went to Fish got more
 a great lot of shooting at Ducks Spartan went
 up Magnet went down Lennie crossed to
 Dundee this morning from Summertown
 wind East (Rain fine) Henry Gene and Henderson
 came to night they had 4 Sturgeon and 4 suckers 23rd
 Lavinia Birth Day 8 years old to day set the line
 Basted with sucker went to Hamilton Brought
 a 2 Sturgeon and the box Henry to the store for
 salt got a Sturgeon from Henry salted his
 Got 2 Plugs of Tobacco from Henderson went
 to Christies to night too Windy to Fish had some
 Wind at the hunters camp on Christies Island
 Rained hard and blowing to night 24th Rev
 Hough's Birth Day Henderson shot a Diver
 this morning went to the line got nothing they got
 Ready and started for Point Morice to hunt
 took his Rope left his sack fine but Windy
 taking the manure out of the Big shed
 Banking inside the little shed North side of the
 house went to the line to night Got a Sturgeon
 25th My Birth Day cleaned a Sturgeon got
 2 scapers on the line finished the Big shed
 Put some manure out on the hay from
 before the Barn door drew the Passbook from
 the lower Point took down the Wedges and split
 the Log 26th Banking Windy hurt my finger
 taking the mat of a Pott my gun I went off
 looking to see a flock of Wild Geese
 27th seen a Peewee on the Pit Point tried for Bait Draw
 Wood 28th I crossed to Summertown Bought 2lb Sea Match
 Pins the Robbers of Jewellery at Summertown 10 Pien arm
 Got 2 Bags of Potatoes 1 Bag of Apples from Hamilton
 John and I went up to the store Henry Gene here
 Jowed up with the East Bill McLeod going to
 tomorrow to the centennial
