James Cameron Island 26th of March
 John Hamilton Cameron's Bay
 18.76 Fine cool Frosty Boy
 on the Bush Boiling Leander
 came from Douquetts 3 Days
 there they went for Ducks
 got 1 The same Duck began
 to Lay some hens Laying the Frog -
 Hawk came froze hard last night
 27th Fine cold frosty Made Syrup
 to Day 2 1/2 Gallons split some Rails
 cutting stove wood. Linnæa very
 unwell yesterday froze hard to night
 28th Unfortunate Day Windy flurries
 of snow Drawing Wood to the camp
 drew some hay from the stack
 cutting stove wood Went for
 Ells got 7, 29th Fine some flurries
 of snow Leander and John K crossed
 to Summerstown with Douquetts
 Boat Burning their Marshes 30th
 Fine Gordon and Leander went to
 Dundee Left their Boat at the
 Mouth of Salmon River Leander
 Bought a Kimmmer for the Cartridge
 Kaffelton Bought a saw Tobacco
 Got his Boot Fixed a Bottle
 Got 2 Ells Boiling not running
 well Straining and Boiling
 Syrup on the House

James Cameron Island 31st of March 1894
 East Wind ice Broke up to the Door
 Shot Ducks Gordon crossed
 gave him 3 Sars with 3 Gallons
 of Syrup for Frank Saplaute
 first payment for the Horse Heard
 Thunder Boys in the Bush brought
 2 Gallons home from the Bush 1st
 of April all Fools Day
 Wind ^{Saw Burned} Boys Boiling for
 the Bush 2nd Made Sugar
 it soft about 100 lb put it in
 a Keg put a Lock on the Keg
 3rd Fine Drew the East of the Marsh hay
 stack Drew some Rails and the
 pile of wood at the apple tree so
 it would thaw got a Black Duck
 and a Whittler the Boys went
 for Ells got 18 Snowed some to night
 and Rained some 4th Fine Boiling
 Syrup Leander to na-houta's Island
 got 4 Ducks Letting the water run
 in places John K crossed to Summ-
 ertown the Grenada crossed from
 Summerstown to Dundee Bought
 Tobacco Powder and shot took 3 Sars
 from Frank Saplaute
 Billy Morris wife Departed on
 of April Buried on the 5th
