 We took load turnips down to Beattie in P.M. brought over 2 loads culls got load off Sam Mc. Kess sleigh to put culls in. Gave supper and 25 cts to tramp put up chop. Willie down town at night got at Philleps extract of malt 25 tea at Armstrongs 20 cts

 Very stormy last night very stormy day snowing calmed down at night cleared off Only Willie and I went down to church Mr W. Vicar preached in A.M. from Titus 1:5. middle clause a sermon on some more of the Presby's questions prayer meeting elders visiting special meetings etc and in evening from 1 Kings 6:7. about character building.

4 Monday  
 Clear frosty day sunny cloudy in A.M. some. Willie took down to Wilsons 1115 lbs cow chop and 1146 pig chop brought up load manure from J. Adams. P.M. spread 4 loads manure No 5 then put the one Willie brought up on lamb that died yesterday that I skinned this morning. I took the skin to Mills got \$1.00 for it then brought up chop. got less ants at Fritts 10 cts
