Goodness". and Mr Mullen at night to united
congregation from "Arise O God and let thy
enemies be scattered" and return to the
many thousands of Israel.

Thawing in morning, cloudy day gradually
turned cold and frosty. Windy at night.
Kept as New Years day. We brought up
Father Mother Auntie Uncle Jim and Mrs
Ricketti for dinner. Fred M^c Ditzge also here for
dinner. John Black drove Father up to
Aunnook to vote. Willie and I drove up in
buggy voted for 'Tom' Dow Commissioner and
Tom Pritchard for Reeve.

Fine winter day frosty, some sunshine
I cut wood in bush. and at night
went to "At Home" in hospital given by

(one to fall wheat) then brought up load
wood from bush
