 from Halifax after bringing out Convales
 ant soldiers, there were over 240 on board

Tues 16 Kind of dull. I finished cutting the Burd
 ocks in the garden. There is a social to
 night on Mrs Mowat's Lawn for the Red Cross
 a light shower about 8 P.M. 2 loaves 2

Wed 17 Rain today. The social was a success
 took in over 2.00. I sent 2.40

 bread 42 1 gal coal oil 25
