Tuesday 26th Cold & fine
I went to Station in morning to meet the children. went down street & bought per ^{\$1.25} overalls ordered 1/2 doz. Photos ^{\$1.25} to be done work after next, we chored around barn in afternoon,

Wednesday 27th Cold
C. Chored around barn all day. I went to Town in morning. bought rope 5 3/4" @ 12¢, 69¢. Paid ⁶⁹ Savages ac, \$1.75 he paid ^{1.75} me 50¢ for saw dust. paid ⁵⁰ Reed ac, \$6.50. Pd. Penfold ac, \$18.25. Paid A. Stone ac ^{\$9.60} 18.25
Paid for mercury ^{1.00} 1.00
paid nails ac \$2.70 2.70

Thursday 28th Cold & l
C & I chored and cut wood, I went to Mt Forest in evening to attend Will & Tom's sale ticket. \$2.75 arrived sat Home about eleven P.M. ^{2.75}

Friday 29th fair & cold
we cleaned cattle & prepared generally in morning, in afternoon all time was used in running the sale. They sold for \$1330.00, Tom's lot was 47 1/2 Wilts was about \$50

Saturday 30th fine
C went to St Vincent this morning and I got home from Mount Forest. Express went to town in afternoon, got things for dues from W. \$1.88 things for self ^{1.00} 1.88
