

- Sept. 4. (Sunday) Fine. A. Mary to Ch. (Communion) Like rain
5. Rain all day. Jim & Luth in 10. A. and S at Corners threshing
6. Warm and wet - Heavy rain all last night. A. and Jim to Fagus with Peas Jim got boots. A. Moir and Russ here. Missed a wall
7. Cooler. Started to cut Buckwheat in 7. Thinning out stocks which were growing badly
8. Fair. all in at home. Put bakings. Thinning out stocks and Peas from Fagus for flood (inclination) 3 bags @ 2.25 @ 2.25 and 1 @ 3.00 = 7.50 A. got to Belton with Peas. Intending to thresh to tomorrow if dry
9. Like rain in evening but kept fair. Windy. Threshing. Below 40 acres. oats and Peas. Fair turn out. 18 hand for 4000 and allowed (Hastings machine) The worst delayed harvest since 1901 on account of Wet. lots of grain to draw in yet.
10. Fine warm. Jim & Luth at Radburn threshing. Took up Load of Peas that was not threshed. Chasing goats to Fagus to be getting leg washed
11. (Sunday) Fair warm. A. Jim Luth to Libs. for Mary to Sunday school
12. Heavy mist in morning. Like rain all day Jim & Luth to Radburn threshing goats to Fagus getting leg pressed books at night. Home (Gauges Re)
13. Good fair. Cut Buckwheat in 7. Started in 11. Jim at H. & O. the street
14. Fine cool. Luth at Hannas pulling Peas. Finished cutting Buckwheat (first stock) started to cut Aug 6 = 39 days
15. Fine. Jim and Luth at Hannas threshing all day. Home in afternoon
16. " " " Threshing Buckwheat
17. " " " Finished Threshing Buckwheat. A. Mary, John to Fagus at night
18. (Sunday) Cloudy. Cool. A. Mary to Ch. Home. Jim, Mary to hands. A. & L.
19. Cool morning. Fine day. Norm. Harriet took cattle away. Sold 4 Cattle to W. Wilson = 35.00 @ 5.00 off = 17.50. French horse Evrene worked all right.
20. Fine Cool. Chasing in 10 (4 hours) 7's. Luth gets bleeds. Fergus
21. " " " Threshing telegraph. Chasing up oats getting threshing wood etc. ^{Heavy of Hastings} Done Threshing
22. First heavy frost. 4 inches. John to Fagus with Cart. 13. 16 @ 3.00 = Shop for horses. Jim at Radburn threshing all day. Jim Luth and S. from 3
23. Frost. hot. Loupit. Threatening Rain all day. Threshed Buckwheat out of stock 9 acres. 240 Bushels 48 days from start to finish of harvest. Country looking fine. Lots of grass. Cattle scarce and dear.
