Diagnosis of Cholecystitis.

W. J. Mayo, (*Am. Journ. Med. Sci.*), observes that the most reliable sign of cholecystitis when the bladder is exposed to view is enlarged glands along the common duct and at the junction of the common and cystic ducts. In cholecystitis of long standing, each lymph nodes may become calcareous. The strawberry gall-bladder is one of the most frequent types of cholecystitis, the mucous membrane being covered with yellow specks.
