 17 Blustery. Clearing wheat. Delivered after from  
 19 Cold. Helping. R. T. to split wood. B. took 6 to work and sent of wheat to Salem  
 20 Drawing wood. took S. M. & Chas. Bank  
 21 To Fallers. Paying for milk. Milk. B. Sawing  
 22 B. to Salem for 7 cows. went to see H. Anderson Re Audit. took 6 Home. Cold  
 23 Joe. Lewis & Wife and H. Miller & wife here  
 24 Cold. Drifting. B. Sawing. took a load of wood (Sunday). B. & M. to A. Morris. Fine day

 18 still cold and very stormy  
 19 Stormy but milder. turning of night. Snow  
 20 & 21 still cold. putting up calving in Pan  
 23 Milk. To Fergus with 3 Indras cattle  
 24 Stormy. young. folks to see Rays  
 25 Fine that it has been for a week  
 26 up to the wood. fine. 6 to Washington  
 27 Took two loads of wood. killing pig at Nicholas. Rain all afternoon. Party at Mr. Thomason. 25. Anniversary of Mr. Widling  
 28 Rain all day. snow at night. putting up 6 in part  
 March 1 (Sunday) Froze up again. Snowing  
 2 Cold & Raw. Putting bedding in bath house  
 3 soft & sunny. 6 to Fergus. Re Lumps  
 4 Frosty morning. To Fergus with Lumps  
 5 Snowing in forenoon. B. with Lumps. So Mrs. Malis. Hurree  
 6 B. sawn with two logs to cut into 2 hogs. A. D. to Fergus in Evening. Blighting B  
 7 killed Cows for Mr. Hannan in forenoon. also one for Mrs. Hannan to live in afternoon. very heavy rain all of forenoon  
 8 (Sunday) still thawing. Milk. seen seen  
 9 Slaying zone. Whala. Running blue pan and Robins seen. finished calving milk  
 10 Making & hanging doors. Ben. Park. Rain all afternoon  
 11 Fine. Large farm of B. G. Loman and Mr. John G. Loman & Mr. Wood. Road. Bridge with it

 March 12 Mild & misty. Building stans  
 13 " " " " No frost for a week  
 14 B. to Belwood with A. Hanna for Lumber. Misty  
 16 B. to Fergus with ship. warm  
 17 Misty. Milk. working at Woodshed  
 18 To B. Lewis to buy cream  
 19 Making stais for woodshed. warm at the season  
 20 To Belwood for Boots (parties) during forenoon  
 21 sharpening saws. cutting out. Place for window  
 23 Putting saws on bathhouse and party bath in window. behind meat & rain (very warm)  
 24 B. to Joe. Wilson. High wind & rain. A. to Fergus with  
 25 Snowing. blowing. Cold. A. to Joe. for Marshall's  
 26 Dull. Raw and cold. B. came home from J. on  
 27 Stewart Dale. Pot. Pulper & Sable. Frosty night  
 28 Clear. and sunny hard frost

 16 blowing to Fergus with A. Hanna  
 17 " " " " but much here being what & Hanna  
 18 Harrowing. A. M. & Aunt May to Fergus  
 20 blowing still cold. frost every night  
 21 " " " " blowing dull cold day (young pig)  
 22 Finished blowing. Raw & cold (A. to Belwood)  
 23 Snowing. Raw. & drifting. still cold. snowing  
 24 Snowing. Milk. Running. A. B. & Realy  
 Watsons sale. light rain  
 25 Clear. Cool. Harrowing. to A. Hannan in  
 27 finished blowing. (Cows) total 40 Bush  
 day of season. Frost still every night. ground  
 28 Frost. Harrowing. Warm. two Breemunt  
 29 Fine & warm. Drifting & planting potatoes in  
 30 very high wind with light rain at night  
 May 1 very high. put and cold all day to Fergus  
 2 B. got. Salt. & Aunt Laid. sold wheat  
 3 Cool. blowing for. stock. Angus. Red  
 4 (Sunday) heaviest. Rain since the snowing  
 5 Snowing. A. B. Pauls. Carrots and Beans. warm  
 6 blowing on track warm  
 7 Cool. putting in shelves in party. to Fergus  
 8 fine. To Fergus. Anderson. Remembrance  
 9 warm. To Fergus with wood to Stuart. plow  
 11 very warm. Wild. Plums in bloom. dry  
 12 still hot and dry. A. M. left for Washington  
 13 blowing hot. Rain needed. Trees well in  
 14 slight rain. very pleasant day. fine. Lick  
 15 still hot & dry. Cool (15 calves out all)  
 16 " " " " Cool. dead
