Willie paid D Allan for barley I got April 10th \$1.30. Mary got butter from Mrs Quairie 51 cts. Fred Bowley in in morning got 6 1/2 bushels oats at 40 cts 260 paid \$2.30

Fine sunny day. Willie took a bag of chops to Currie brought up load manure from Stats. I took back 6 loads put all in potato land. Mary down in P.M. got at Woods dry goods 74 can salmon 15 stone black 5 stone hat 17. total 1.11 at Mills meat 30 bag seed 24 lbs 30 butter mung from Phoebe \$4.93
