Lymphangitis.

In glandular inflammation the glands themselves are very rarely the primary seat of the malady, and therefore, whenever such enlargement is found, the primary cause must be sought for elsewhere in the vicinity. For example, in the case of swelling of the submaxillary glands, the condition of the nose, ears, eyes, mouth, throat, and larynx, must be carefully investigated, and in 90 per cent. of all such cases the primary cause will be found in one of these situations, and not in the glands themselves.—*Clinical Memoranda, Brand & Keith.*
