Very frosty day snowing in morning and last night mostly sunny. Willie took 900 lbs pig chop to mill came back and we hauled load hay over from other barn. P.M. I and Bella went to church Mr. Silway of Guilford preached from Matt 26: 8 last verse. Bob Blocker gave baby baptised. I gave coll 5 ts. I bought two books for missionary accounts and minutes at Phillips 20 ts. Willie down town P.M. got chop 59 ts also 1000 lbs corn @ \$1.50 per cent \$15.00 500 lbs white dust @ \$1.25 per cent \$6.25. 500 lbs back dust @ 60 ts \$3.00 paid I have down to meeting of managers at night. Kate in afternoon of the Murphy horse died very suddenly this morning.
