- Mon Oct 28. Rained heavily all morning, we washed, fire light again.
- Tues Oct 29. Fine and mild, a beautiful day. Aunt Mattie went to Aunt Lizzie's, got her coat dyed \$2.50. I was out, went in to see N. Smellie's house, potatoes from M. Deans \$2.00. no fire.
- Wed. Oct 30. Fine and very mild. Aunt Mattie came home, Mrs R - Simpson called, we got a ton of Coal \$11.50. Willie brought sweet Apples, and a Pumpkin.
- Thurs Oct 31. Hollow"em - fine and mild. Miss Edey called. Tax Collector. V.B.
- Fri Nov 1. Fine and cooler. Aunt Mattie and I called at F. Bow's.
- Sat Nov 2. Fine but quite cold and windy I went for a walk. Annie here in the eve, then we went for a walk after.
- Sun Nov 3. Fine after a heavy white frost, dull in afternoon. I went to morning church. Aunt Nellie and I, and Aunt Mattie and I at eve-church, Annie and I for a walk in afternoon.
