 30 lbs, Zahn order for 10.25 at Phillips
 cost 12 lbs got at mill 42 Ton dust
 \$4.00 cash. We worked at getting
 binder ready Willie drove machine
 down about 4 P.M. got at Chapman
 binder which 50 lbs binder tongue \$3.00
 I over at hods in morning to see if I could
 get these stock racks but J Dix was to
 get it so we wanted ours. I also went
 over to hods at night to see their binder tongue.
