Mr James Cameron Island October  
 Drawing Wood 2<sup>nd</sup> Drawing Wood haled  
 3<sup>rd</sup> Windy 4<sup>th</sup> Bismarck to a Spots to N W 40  
 Raining Windy Picking Grapes 5<sup>th</sup> Fine Day  
 Cutting and Drawing Wood from the Pit Point  
 6<sup>th</sup> Windy Fine Went to Dunder Bismarck and  
 to 4 Tubs of Butter 15.48 To Mr Long Bought  
 70 Rope 4<sup>th</sup> 56 Bot Worm 25 Paper Tase 5 2 squares  
 of Blue 10 1/2 lb Pepper 12 1/2 lb Starch 5 3 lb nails  
 12 cents 1/2 lb Powder 20 Cash 5 sack of salt 8 caps 10  
 7.35 " 8.13 Dew Bought of Mr Smallman 1 lb of Flour  
 2.60 oil 15 Drows 25 Irons 25 Tonge spear fiddle  
 to Blacksmith 30 Bought of M & C Cash 2  
 Cotton 3.85 3 lb of Tea 1 6 qds of Sateete 3 2 pair 2.10  
 1 pair 1.25 1 pair 2.25 1 pair 2.50 comes to 18.5 30  
 Butter 6 Dollars leaves 12.5 Bought of T R 6 qds  
 of Slupe 1 Went up to Shannons Mill  
 not making yarn Mr Hummel came to  
 Tent Mr Steve and Mr Bientch 7<sup>th</sup> Fine  
 Day went up to the Tent Mr Hume  
 here came from Lancaster had a chat with him  
 first Wild Geese last night and a great many  
 flying this evening very high some Black  
 Ducks to night making a noise foggy this  
 morning Baby sick Rowena sick all sick  
 whooping cough 8<sup>th</sup> Drawing Wood Mowing some  
 Mr Hume for Potatoes Eggs and Butter 12<sup>th</sup> day  
 I treated me with good old Rye Drawing Wood  
 9<sup>th</sup> Drawing and cutting in the oak field Fine  
 10<sup>th</sup> He 11 qts Men 26<sup>th</sup> Motters Birth Day  
 1844 Fine Gordon Randolph Tommy Kate Leslie Baker  
 here I went to see Mr Hume at the Tent 11<sup>th</sup>  
 drew some sticks for a shed made a stack 38  
 in Back Marsh Ploughing Potatoe ground 7<sup>th</sup> me  
 12<sup>th</sup> Commenced Blanking East end of the house  
 Raining high East Wind

Mr James Cameron Island 13<sup>th</sup> Oct  
 Blanking the East end of the house by fine  
 East Wind Mr A Toy and John Bowen here  
 30 Butter 10 Dollars gave him a Bottle  
 of Wine Leander and I up to see Mr Hume  
 of him over at Lemays I treated us sent  
 for a Saw to Montreal he says he  
 will sell me his Ducks not plenty  
 14<sup>th</sup> Went to Lancaster with the Wool  
 14 lb Paid a Dollar on it to be made  
 on the 23<sup>rd</sup> to be made coars 13 cents a lb  
 Fine E Wind changed to South Wind a Blew  
 a Gale sent Bismarck to the Store for a  
 1 lb of Crackers 10 and a Bottle of Worm  
 Medicine 25 Passed Suses Island and turned  
 Back stop a good while there then tried  
 for the Squaw Island and got there with  
 hard work made up our minds to stop  
 all night there but made another  
 start and got home with hard  
 work very high wind working at Grapes  
 9 Gallons of Juice 15<sup>th</sup> very windy the tops  
 of the Stacks blew down water very low  
 with the wind this morning and at night  
 working at the Blanking some cutting  
 on the Pit Point 1 Boat came up today  
 the Granada did not come out of Dunder  
 the wind was too high Mr Hume  
 here Bought 1/2 Bushel of Potatoes 3 lb of  
 Butter 10 qds 13 Bead Paid 1 Dollar  
 gave Bismarck 25 cents for going up  
 with him 16<sup>th</sup> Day to be at Lancaster  
 17<sup>th</sup> Fine some few rains of Snow the  
 fishermen's Cines broke with the wind  
 Housse took me up his cross cut saw 1.50 it looks  
 pretty good took the Leaves of the Turnips
