- 15 Sabbath. This has been a fine day. Quite a number in Church. Rev. Wm. Ferguson preached
- 16 I began to write a letter to Murdy on Friday and I am going to mail it tonight. I am sending \$5.00 to buy a few things Toronto Bank No 105009. It is pretty stormy. I went to a party at Archy McKus. Pa. paid some accounts in the stores
- 17 Very stormy. I did not get home until 7 AM. Some people were delayed until evening in the village. No mail today. The Men did not go down County. I came with the ten
- 18 Ah Wednesday Rehearsal in the Dr. house tonight Jimmie went to the store and got an old blue coat with brass buttons he is going to wear it at the concert
- 19 I got 4 lb sugar 25 cts 3 lb apples 25 cts line 15 15 7
- 20 We all went to the concert tickets 25 & 15 cts
- 21 Pretty good concert got 49 dollars. The boys asked the performers to come to our house and dance by candle. got the gate today & the velvet
- 22 The weather is keeping cold.
- 23 We had a pleasant evening Saturday danced until 11 PM. we were in bed by 12
- 24 This has been a fine day sunshine all day. This was a fine morning but it became dull in the afternoon. I am trying to make a board
- 25 Wednesday. A Womens League Mission organization this evening. I met at the church
- 26 Thursday. I did not pass me Northward. I went
- 27 The first day of our sacrament. Got a flower reflected
- 28 Finished my board. The weather this week has been lovely. Rosie had a helper calf. Friday night
