colder. Dad took Sid to school this morning and
I did chores and May & I trimmed the gladiolus
corves and got them ready to send away. Dad cleaned
up the barn floor and we put through a few
oats before dinner and cleaned the dirt & a lot

of the light outs out. They had quite a weight to them
as they had been through the mill. I didn't do anything
but chores this afternoon. Alan Law came and got the
clipping machine to clip one of his horses. Dad took
off the screen doors and put a fire in the hall stove
as they expected Hubby & Mr. Farnsworth, Aunty
& Aunty Alice over to-night. But as it was such
a bad night none of them came. Dad went down
at four o'clock and drove Sid home. He went down
to see if Aunty would come over and she was half
inclined to but they both thought the weather was too bad.
