Hattie staid all night. Marjorie mended the horse blanket very cold yet  
Sat 8. Marjorie & the youngsters went to Chippewa took 8<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> Butter & 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>  
overshoes 1.75 soda biscuit 2.0 bread 15<sup>2</sup>/<sub>3</sub> yams 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> hand paper 3. Garrison  
tromouque 25; I churned for ourselves 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> took 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> with the 7 we had  
on hand round my overshoes. I made 3 apple pies & one mince  
dreadful cold wind snow quite deep down in mind  
I called here in the evening. Emma Marshall came down to Well  
Sun 9 Hattie & Emma went to Well Hills. Well & Dan went to Well  
village. Arthur went to Harvey Hills. snowed terribly bad  
Mon 10 Dan came over real early & stayed until 4 4 o'clock  
then went to Tom Somervilles. quite stormy in forenoon but  
sunshine. every time Paul took to the coughs. a person would  
help getting a cold his son has two, throat  
Tue 11 Dan went to see Ray had time there they went to  
Well Hills for a visit then to the Greelys for the 8<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> supper

Jan 11 & Ethel Miller came down, Tom Mc Gredie went after them  
& took them to his place for the evening. Dan took Hattie up  
Arthur took the teacher up they got home 5 O'clock in the morning  
I finished my new shirt & got it on. I changed my over shoes girl 2.75  
Wed 12. Hattie & Arthur went to Grinnellville to get her both on one  
of Feb 12. Dan took Hattie & Ethel to see Mrs James Well to see her Arthur  
drawed a load of wood in the forenoon & one in the afternoon & Luis  
Brewer one big loads all of them I chunred & worked the butter  
Marjorie baked bread her throat was ever better. Party in Alex Mc Gredie  
the teacher in Well for tea going in the party then stay there all  
night. Dan here in tea. good sleighing & not a bad night  
Paul got home near 3 O'clock

Thur 13. wind strong east - goes right through one. Well &  
Arthur went to Welland got fence posts 40 @ 12<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> 4,80. got  
Arthur new cutter. John & Tom Mc Gredie to the other house for tea  
Dan went home to dog. The roads getting drifted full  
Friday 14 drifted all night & all day today wind still east  
snow in every hole & corner. terribly slay the youngsters  
went to school 4 hr school there was no bi a party in Tom  
Korrels. I brought Tom Mc Gredie came over after tea  
I dont see how they will go the roads must be blocked  
I am glad Paul is here to do the chores this stormy day

Sat 15 a better day but roads blocked in places especially  
north & south roads John Marshall & family to Well Arthur  
went over in the big sleigh at night they all went to Grinnell  
Paul walked to Chippewa & got 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> sugar tea 15 bread 10.  
today 5 lemons 5.45<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> of my money 25 of Paul board money I ready in  
apple sauce cake & two apple pies. Paul cut a big pile of wood to sell

Sun 16 Ethel Miller went to church with the Greelys came back  
they all stayed in Well to dinner also the minister & his brother  
hardly any one in church The roads are too bad & almost  
over in the afternoon went home to get supper. Hattie went with  
the minister to Beavertown. Arthur took the teacher to Chippewa church  
over
