- 18 Fine day Muddy went to Gore Station for Anna & Mabel. They both look well. To 4 1/2 stew at Mc Intyres charge
 To 1 bottle pickles 20 ds., another 25 mixed mustard 20 65
- 19 sugar 30, molasses 15, From Englishman 15 2⁰⁰ sent two pans bread 40. 5 lbs steak 30 charge.
 lemons 42 dry oranges

- 20. Rain scarcely day, got a few apples from Mr Gregor, kettle lard 35, 2 lbs butter 42 57
 steak at Mc Intyres charged. 3 lbs 30
- 21 Fine day, I did not go to church today Mr & Mrs Govin in in evening
- 22. Mable went to Lancaster with Mr Govin. Rain in afternoon
- 23 Tuesday's steak charged, 3 loaves 15
- 24 Anna Mable & Jimmie went to Lancaster to get a sail in Mr Tanners yard
 Mr & Mrs Govin went along.
- 25. To 4 lbs butter. Visitors at Browns last night - Mrs Blacklock and daughter were here all night. To 3 lbs sausage
- 26 Very fine day, Ann went to see Bridie in forenoon, the girls & our boys took dinner at Browns. It is now 9. P. M and Muddy has taken the girls to Lancaster to take the train for Cornwall, then the boat for Toronto, 4 loaves 20. 7 lb tea 20 40
 Jimmie got Thomas to cut the oats finished last evening
- 27. To 2 lb sausage from Blackstead, one lb Japan tea Muddy 35⁰⁰
- 28 Fine day, large congregation strangers in church
- 29 Jimmie got in the oats, had 1 carload and Jim Smith, Mrs Duncan Robertson and daughter Flour of Montreal, called
 Muddy 1 day at 10⁰⁰ 1 1/2 days at Fair ground 150
- 30. Muddy two times 24⁰⁰ Muddy sent me a basket of sweet apples. To 40 lbs sugar 132⁰⁰
- 31 Mrs John Grant and Mrs Lewis of Cornwall & Miss Maggie Dingwall, called and remained to tea, Hugh Pedgley 9⁰⁰ for rent Jimmie paid 100.00 to the bank at Fair ground
