 took 4 hams and two sides up to Mills smoke house
 I ordered at Armstrongs 4 lbs
 mangels and 2 lbs sugar beet manure also
 salt. Sold to Flemming's hay 50cts

Cold day cloudy and sunny. We spread 5
 loads manure in No 6 and brought over load
 hay in A.M. In P.M. Willie spread load
 with 3 horses then plowed till six. I went
 to Mrs Alex Barnett and Mrs R Curless'
 funerals in P.M. The girls went down to
 funeral of the latter, a large turnout.
 Ruby calved last night. Willie gave 25cts to handle man
 We let sheep out to-day. meat 25cts

 at night. I brought over two and a
 post from Schanis of Wilkes and dressed one
 Willie took load manure back and plowed
 & harrowed A.M. P.M. raining we cleaned barn

 feed \$4.00 sow \$1.00 in full to date
