24 I did not go to church in the morning, and was sorry, for Mr Burnett preached there was an exchange of pulpits. Mr Given preached in Mounttown for Mr Mathewson and in Williamstown for Mr Mathewson also Willie Slacks little girl Mirial died this morning 3.30 I was there came home at 5 P.M.

25 Burns birthday, never kept in Williamstown

26 Slacks baby buried today very cold and stormy I went to see Mary McDonnell (Tom) who is very unwell she never recovered from the operation performed on her for cancer, it is all through her body

27 Still cold Children getting ready for masquerade at skating rink Thursday  
got 1/2 lb tea <sup>tea paid</sup> 45. Han got cloth at Hedges 2.50 - 2.85  
<sup>cloth charged</sup>

28 I began to make the pants and expect to have them done for the masquerade

29 All the children were at the rink last night and enjoyed it. Murphy came from Cornwall

30 Sat up all last night at Dan Pugh's his wife is very bad with the grippe. Finished Rans pants done some ironing  
2 1/2 lb balls 50

31 I was all last night at Dan Pugh's his wife died this morning about 3.30. I did not go to the morning service, but went in the evening
