- 4 got home at 9 o'clock to night there was a good display of every thing Ad come to Woods last night Mary Jane McNeil Miss Smith & Bennett come with him
- 5 Ad is helping W^m McNeil to thresh they expect to go to Brucees at noon fine weather

- 9 I picked 10 rows of the ~~cabbage~~ there is fearful wind this afternoon with some rain the fences
- 11 I set up some of the pines as Ad went to St. Michaels with the salt train Mr. Peck Soil bought a coat store for one dollar & ten dollars for the store to
- 14 Ad & William pulled the row in the field & garden I husked & pulled some little rain
- 12 Ad drew a load of wood and other chores the Row Mr. Eddie came on the Cepness then Rev. Mr. Eddie preached this morning & sermonizing
- 14 Ad & Wallace commenced to plow & scrap ait the Sillier in the woodshed he is making 14 feet in width & the breadth of the woodshed
