I cut rest of dumbie hay Willie started yesterday and Willie went down town got meat Shortreed's 140 goods on for at 7 & 8 8.00 for the hands & furrill at Mannis 25 ct bread 25 ct for 20 ct he brought up 7 & M. N.S. up all day finished turnips bred some more corn. PM we S & D Raked up some hay & colled it before rain. Willie drove 7 & M down. I joined some
