Fine day sunny warm looked like rain evening. Mr Crow preached AM from Ephesian 4:1. and in evening from Acts 4:13. last clause. Only W & M town AM. Set night.

19 Monday

Exceedingly heavy rain last night again raining most A.M. cleared off by night. warm. We connected the cut 'Jno Black' drains in No 5 and plowed in drains to-day. I drove up to Armstrong at night. Punch fell & broke shaft in way down.

20 Tuesday

Mostly fine sunny, cloudy at times also a few drops rain. warm. Willie cut hay in No 7 next barn. I backfilled drain through hay in No 7 I also connected some more drains J.B. ones and sowed rest of rape in new land No 6 back. N.S. up all day thinning turnips. J. Robinson and wife Belle came here PM in their new auto stayed for tea gave girls a hot ride.
