18<sup>th</sup>

19<sup>th</sup>

Wed, Mother was down to Yatchers all day helping work for the raising. Father went out to subscribe the afternoon work hard to Yatchers raising and deflated for the raising from Methodist church. A Mrs. Robinson came up this afternoon for raising tonight. He and I went up as far as I can. My horse accompanied Ethel and I went down at 11 o'clock.

20<sup>th</sup>

Thu. I lived was here tonight last night. This morning Father, Mother and I went and Richard went down to Yatchers. It would not have raising in account of rain raised hard most of the day. The afternoon work they came home Hugh raising with them. He was out for the raising. Tonight Father, I lived and they went up the road asking hands to raising tomorrow morning. Ethel and I went home.

21<sup>st</sup>

Fri. Yatchers had his raising today. Father and I went down to Yatchers this morning and stayed all day. Fire day.
