came for 30 bushels turnips in P.M. Girls called on Mrs John M. Kee P.M. We all went down at night to Presiding meeting in Melville church. Mr Paterson of Toronto spoke on Taylor's Missionary movement Mr Shearer of Hastings need of evangelists etc.

Tuesday

Mostly cloudy a little sunshine dense snow flurries at noon and intervals P.M. not very frosty. Willie and I drove over to Elora A.M. under the impression it was worse than here but it was only seed fair. P.M. we went to Jim Able's sale for Hoffman harness. bought waggon & harness. Girls drove town P.M. with Lucy got at Rendell goods 75 cts took butter down to Willie & Mrs Wilson.

Wednesday

Exceedingly stormy day snowing and blowing drifting, sunshine at intervals. frosty. Willie drove down town got \$14.00 out of bank sent order for pattern Phelps Stamp etc 22 cts came back then I took time went out paid J. Shedd \$1.00 for bull carrie then went to J. Able for waggon and harness bought yesterday \$5.25. P.M. Willie cleaned harness got at Ables I cleaned seed barley. Sheep had 2 lambs to-day.

Thursday

Fine sunny day frosty but thawing considerable in rushville ^{clean} Willie ~~took~~ harness A.M. Drilled apples in cellar etc. P.M. we spread 5 loads manure No 7. Mr Craig came for 20 more bushels turnips paid in full \$5.00. Girls called on Mrs Dunn in evening & had bad cold. Willie and I finished oiling Able harness in evening.
