We worked at drain to-day got tiles laid up about through the bush. The girls and I called at Gindels at eight the other afternoon and Bell shook there.

Friday

Fine sunny day. P.M., cloudy & M like rain. Wm Hayward and Frank Gibson up all day helping with bush drain. We got tiles laid about up to fence plowed some out in No 6 extending the drain up several chains. Willie harnessed in No 6. He drove up to see cattle before tea.

12

Saturday

Frost last night. Fine sunny day. Gibson and Hayward up all day digging drain. We plowed drain in No 6 with drill plow with endboards off we got tiles laid through into other field. We paid Gibson 6 75 \$3.00 & Hayward \$3.00 cheque on S.B. I went down town at night paid Nichols 75 \$ for shovel Frank Gibson got this morning. Wm Clark eggs 45 cts 45 Willie dropped pig and horse. D. Red and Mr Ruck came in morning the latter a German Canadian judged our corn for field crop competition
