Fine sunny day almost warm thawing a lot no drifting now considerable snow in places yet. Willie took to seals 1650 lbs hay from B. Match then took 10 bags 75 lbs potatoes down to Armstrongs at 75cts bag in afternoon. We took old manure from hot bed to garden worked some fresh over again. Mr Pick here in PM getting some barley and oats for seed. We brought over load hay from other barn in evening. Mary down town PM got at Walls Steak 30 olive oil Phillips 10. Took slight work to other barn a young sheep had two lambs today.
