cloudy a little snow fall. Willie and
I drove down town with Jennie in
cutler got at Mennis made 2 glass
lamp and lantern 20cts 1 1/2 gal coal oil
at Phillips cream Carter 10cts flour at Fords 20cts
We set up tread power to-day

Fine mild day cloudy and sunny.
D. Allen brought down his two horses
and we tried the tread power with
his two and Lucy we chopped 100 lbs
in 12 minutes we tried it also in P.M.
but belt came off continually so went
home horses and I hauled back load
manure. Mary and I drove down
at night. I paid Fred Armstrong
for afe \$10.50 manure \$4.50 Received for straw
given in 1904 \$10.25 got at Cartons flour afe
Geo Crabb bought 100 lbs baked wine \$3.00
