I drove down A.M. in sleigh took some cedar home got Magwoods to telephone up to Jacksons, re getting Colly to thresh for us. P.M. we killed a lamb

## Tuesday

Snowing, mostly cloudy some sunshine thanvish! We hauled 2 loads of spoiled silage from top of silo which we threw out of gable window into sleigh around to henhouse. I boarded up doors etc. in pig pen and stuffed straw in them. Wm Byers our P.M. brought head plane he got <sup>end</sup> of last spring. We weighed 14lb of gasoline and put it into tank P.M. Willie chopped pig. May went down home P.M. to stay all night.

Thawing a lot mostly sunny sleighing about gone. Willie drove down in sleigh got 75 at Shortneck meet 75cts May got at 70 3 cents 15cts more she came up with Willie. We hauled back one load manure A.M. and 4 P.M. to pile on sand hill near other barn. I made a partition gate for to divide shephouse. I also brought gates home in sleigh from back part of farm
