

Camden, Gore January 1884

This Jan 3rd a blustering cold day I was thrashing out peas, the boys doing the chores. Fri Jan 4th clear part of the day and cold, was thrashing peas, the boys was getting up wood. Sat Jan 5th clear part of the day and cold, the thermometer at Zero this morning, cleaned up the peas to day and cutt and took up a load of wood up to the Church this afternoon. Sun Jan 6th clear part of the day and cool.

Mon Jan 7th cloudy not quite so cold to day as it has been very cold last night and this morning, John and I were getting up a little stove wood. Walter was at School.

Tue Jan 8th cloudy and snow most of the day, not doing much to day.

Wed Jan 9th clear part of the day, cold and blustering I was thrashing out peas, Anne sick had the Dr down to see her, he thinks she has the Bilious Fever.

Thu Jan 10th cloudy and cool, the sky looks this evening as if we might have rain, I took a grist to Mill to day.

Fri Jan 11th cloudy and cold, took a load of wheat to Dresden sold it to Horner and Carscallen for \$1.00 per bushel.

Sat Jan 12th cloudy and cold, we wear putting up a load of grain to get chopt. Sun a little better we think. Sun Jan 13th cloudy and soft.

Mon Jan 14th cloudy and cool, took a load of grain to Florence Mill to get chopt. Anne some better.

Tue Jan 15th cloudy and cool, I was thrashing out peas this fore noon after noon went for grist I took to Mill yesterday.

Wed Jan 16th clear part of the day and pleasant was cleaning up peas and sawing stove wood most of the day.

Thu Jan 17th clear fore part of the day pleasant after noon cloudy, I was most of the day out hunting for a black Squirrel for Anne but could not find one.

Fri Jan 18th cloudy and moderate, John and I cutting stove wood most of the day.

Sat Jan 19th cloudy and cold went down to Dresden for a few things for Anne she is still quite poorly.

Sun Jan 20th clear part of the day and cold, Mon Jan 21st cloudy and cold, we wear drawing rails and wood from over the river, Anne some better.
