Monday 6th June
 I took children to school and
 went to vote. then left cutter at
 penfolds to be fixed, and painted
 W.B. Chored & cleaned bot stalls
 all day. I sent \$10.00 to American
 Sheep Breeder and \$3.00 to
 Accountant. National Records
 Ottawa. E.P. Rosebud 2nd in Wheat

Tuesday 7th June
 We Chored in morning
 I went to town for lumber
 to fix cow stalls.
 got 800 ft. at 15. = \$12.00 12 00
 got clothes line arms fixed ^{20c} 20
 Pd. Dr Keys acs. 21.00 21 00
 Pd. Goldies ac 41 85

Wednesday 8th June
 we did chores and
 took five heifers up to
 Roth's Hotel Pilkington &
 met Mr Low & he took
 them on. he is to keep them
 at \$4.00 per month. Had Ernest
 helping us. 3 heifers have been
 at Hendersons 1 1/2 months
 at 4 = \$18

Thursday 9th Cold
 J. Webster hauled manure ^{supp was 70} 70
 W.B. & I chored & put floor
 in two stalls. I went to town
 in morning Pd. McCormick 120.00 120 00
 on furnace but 12.75
