It didn't shell very badly after it was dry. We hauled in one load before dinner but didn't put it off. This afternoon we hauled in four more and put them off over the granary. Frank and I drove Queen out to Bill Sidways the night to take him a look, he doesn't seem to be improving very fast. We got home about dark and then Frank, Dick and I went for a swim. It was fine. Friday.

Saturday July 19th

We hauled in four more loads of alake this morning besides a jay of caught grass which we threw in the basket after the hay. We put all that we hauled this morning in the hay. This afternoon we then hay went down town. The band played in the park as this was proclaimed a holiday by the King to celebrate peace. There was a big crowd in town but they were all down at the lake. I stayed down at Aunt's for tea. I received a cheque for my Laidlaw at 40 steps.

Sunday July 20th

Frank, Sid and I went down to Sunday school this morning and Dad & Ernie went down to church. Mary and I took up the collection. Dad & Ernie stayed down town this afternoon. Ernie & Sid stayed to tea and Dad drove down after the church for them. He came home at six and helped me do chores. Frank, Dick and I had dinner together and then Dick went down town but Frank and I stayed home all afternoon.

Monday July 21st

We finished hauling the alake in two loads this morning and then hauled two loads of wheat before dinner. But as we pulled in the barn with the second load it began to rain quite hard so we didn't get any more in the day. This afternoon I started down town to get my money order cashed but Dick over took me on the wheel so I sent it down with him and I came home. Frank, Dad and I cleaned up some rats as we want to put some next year's seed away now as there will probably not be much next spring. Old Mr. Ross came in about five o'clock to see again.
