It was raining in forenoon, now 9 P.M. it is cold Spider was collecting for minister Pa gave him \$2.50 will send 50cts again I was to see Mrs Kentail, she is some better. Pa paid the 50 3

3 Nice day Murdy went to Apple Hill for Bird and came home by Morris' Mills & got the oat meal. Bird bought - 2 cows 3.50. 1 muff 1.58 a dress of red serge for me 3.00 and some things for herself. She got 3 yds table linen 1.50

4 A large congregation Hugh Ann, got on the platform and sat in a chair

5 Fine day Election of Councillors

6 Jimmie went to Lancaster to get a tooth pulled but it would not come out I did not go to the meeting tonight

7 Prayer Meeting in Mr Watsons tonight.

8 The weather is very fine and the roads are good. The Womens Meeting at the Manse today. W. present My offering 25cts. Walter Slack paid Pa \$4.00 for 1 months rent. Dyer is troubling about hay & straw, boys took 1 load of straw from Whitford Mrs Kentail is worse

9 Another fine day Auntie is not so well There was a good meeting tonight in St. A's Birdie & I went to see Mrs Kentail, she is some better. Dan came up
