Mild day cloudy, sunny at times rain in evening and windy. Mr Coburn of Toronto preached in A.M. from 1st Jo 3:1. and in evening from Luke 5:27, 28. only Willie down at night - Church call 1.00

Very windy last night. frost. Fine sunny mild day. We finished plowing new land in No 4 and plowed garden. Willie fitted some storm windows. Uncle Geo Dodge and aunt Maggie down today went home in evening.

Tuesday

Fine day sunny and cloudy a little frost last night. Willie took load straw down to Bease and brought up load manure from Steels I took another load back from pig pen both to T.L. field. Willie plowed Perin plow horses in P.M. No 7 other side turnips. I cut wood in bush. Birds down town in P.M. got at Geo W. woods within bottom 9 lace 25 at 7 o'clock tea 20 sold eggs to Fort 11/2 dy 30 received from J. Beattie for turnips delivered to Wm Beattie Nov 8th 11.00 weighing 20 Mrs Phillip up in P.M. paid for butter 4.80 Received from Auntie for butter 30cts
